



What do we gain and what do we lose on our journey towards freedom?

A dance / ode to womens' power and their ability to move mountains. ROSA, a peasant Indigenous woman from Ixtacamaxtitlan, located in the highlands of Puebla State, flees her community with her six small children on her back. As she escapes a life of abuse at the hands of her husband and her in-laws, she crosses valleys, climbs mountains, and faces enormous challenges. After three weeks she arrives in Mexico City where she will face her greatest challenge yet: brutal discrimination. This will force her to make a choice that will have an impact on her, her children, and will reverberate for generations to come.

Through movement, theatre, video and documentary, ROSA highlights the female body, its relationship to the land, and its capacity to resist, survive, and transform.
